

# NOKIA WI-FI APP AND ROUTER SETUP

1



Download the Nokia Wi-Fi App. Click **Get Started**.

On the bottom of the router, there is a QR code, username, password of your router MAC address, and Serial Number. When you select **Scan Code**, it will access your camera (give permission if asked). Use the QR code reader to scan the code. This will save the password on your phone's clipboard so you can paste it into the password field when you join the Wi-Fi network.

Select **Next** to continue.

Connect the Ethernet cable to the BLUE port on the router. Select **Next**. Plug in the power adapter and connect it to your Beacon.

*The app will ask you to restart your modem. BTES doesn't use modems so just select Next.*

On the bottom of the router, you will find the power switch. Turn the router on (power switch should show green). The router may go through some initialization which could take several minutes. The light on the front may flash yellow or white. You might not see it immediately, but it should show up in your available Wi-Fi networks.

Go to your phone settings and open the Wi-Fi section. When you see your Beacon, select it. When it asks for the password, either long press in the password field and select paste or manually enter it as printed on the bottom of the router.

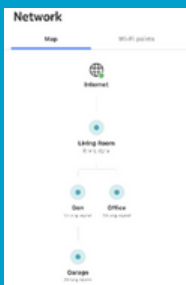
The router will complete the setup and register with our server. The light on the front of the router may turn red. Once it is done it should turn white or blue. Once setup is complete, you can create an account to manage your router remotely.

You can change the network name and password to match your previous network information. This will allow your existing devices to connect without having to link to each device to a new network.

*If needed, you can also add an additional access point if you have one. Select the **Add Wi-Fi point** to continue. It will prompt you to scan the QR code of the additional Beacon.*

The **Home Screen** will show you the current status of your network, number of devices, and number of access points (if installed).



The **Devices Screen** shows the currently connected devices and their signal strength. It also has a section for devices that are not currently connected.

The **Network Screen** shows a map of your network. You can tap any of the devices to get more detailed information about them. The Wi-Fi Points section has the list of your devices. You can add new Wi-Fi access points from this screen.

The **Settings Screen** has setup information for your Wi-Fi networks, account, and other information.
